## Overview:

As per the regulations under the *Health Professions Act* (HPA) registrants must participate in continuing education and professional development as a requirement for renewal of registration with NLCHP.

The CE/PD requirements policies are developed by health profession Colleges.

## Policy:

Registrant's who fail to complete their CE's, including the submission of CEs into the online portal are not eligible for licensure renewal and will not be issued a practicing license until such time as CE requirements are met.

New registrants who register after the beginning of the registration year will not be required to complete the minimum CE/PD requirement for their initial year of registration.

## Procedure:

- 1. Applicants applying for renewal of registration must meet all CE requirements for the previous licensure year, including the submission of CE documents into the online portal.
- 2. Registrants with extenuating circumstances and who were thus unable to meet CE requirements should contact the Registrar.



- **3.** Registrant's who fail to complete their CE's, including the submission of CEs into the online portal are not eligible for licensure renewal and will not be issued a practicing license until such time as CE requirements are met.
- **4.** The registrant's employer/s will be notified.
