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December 31 Deadline for Continuing Education

Have you started logging your education in the CE portal for the December 31, 2025, deadline?

The introduction of a new registrant management system in January 2026 requires all registrants (except medical radiation technologists**) to have all continuing education activities for the calendar year 2025, completed and logged in the CE portal **by December 31, 2025**. This requirement is not new, however in the past registrants were able to access the CE portal following the December 31 deadline. Due to database transitions, the 2025 CE portal **will be closed** on December 31, 2025.

Reminder: You will not be able to renew your practicing/non practicing registration for 2026 - 2027 until you have completed and uploaded to the CE portal, all CE requirements for the calendar year 2025.

Due to the transition period between the two registration management systems, education completed between January 1 – March 31st, 2026 can be used as CE credits for the 2026 – 2027 only.

Continuing Education Program and Medical Radiation Technologists

Medical Radiation Technologists are not required to submit continuing education to NLCHP for the current registration year (2025 – 2026). Currently, MRTs cannot access the NLCHP's online CE portal due to NLCHP launching a new registration management system, which includes a CE portal, in January 2026. As a result, MRTs are exempt from the continuing education program for the current registration year (2025 – 2026). MRTs will be required to complete the online continuing education program for the April 1, 2026 – March 31, 2027, registration year.

Is your professional liability insurance (PLI) expiring December 31?

Are you an MLT, LHP, MRT, XHP, DH, MW? If so, your PLI is expiring soon.

Registrants whose Professional liability insurance (PLI) expires December 31, 2025, are reminded to update their professional liability insurance policy on file and upload your certificate to the NLCHP portal as soon as they are received. Due to the transition period between the two registration management systems, you can upload to the current NLCHP portal until November 28th. The new registration management system will be available on December 8th and you will be required to update this information on the new portal. Therefore, there is a black out period between November 29th and December 7th.

The registration management system is set up to automatically switch a registrant's status to inactive on January 1st if you do not have an updated professional liability insurance

policy on file and upload your certificate. A current professional liability insurance on your profile is a registration requirement and therefore you will not be able to work.

Please log into your portal and update your professional liability insurance policy and upload your certificate. A purchase receipt of professional liability insurance will not be accepted as proof of insurance.
